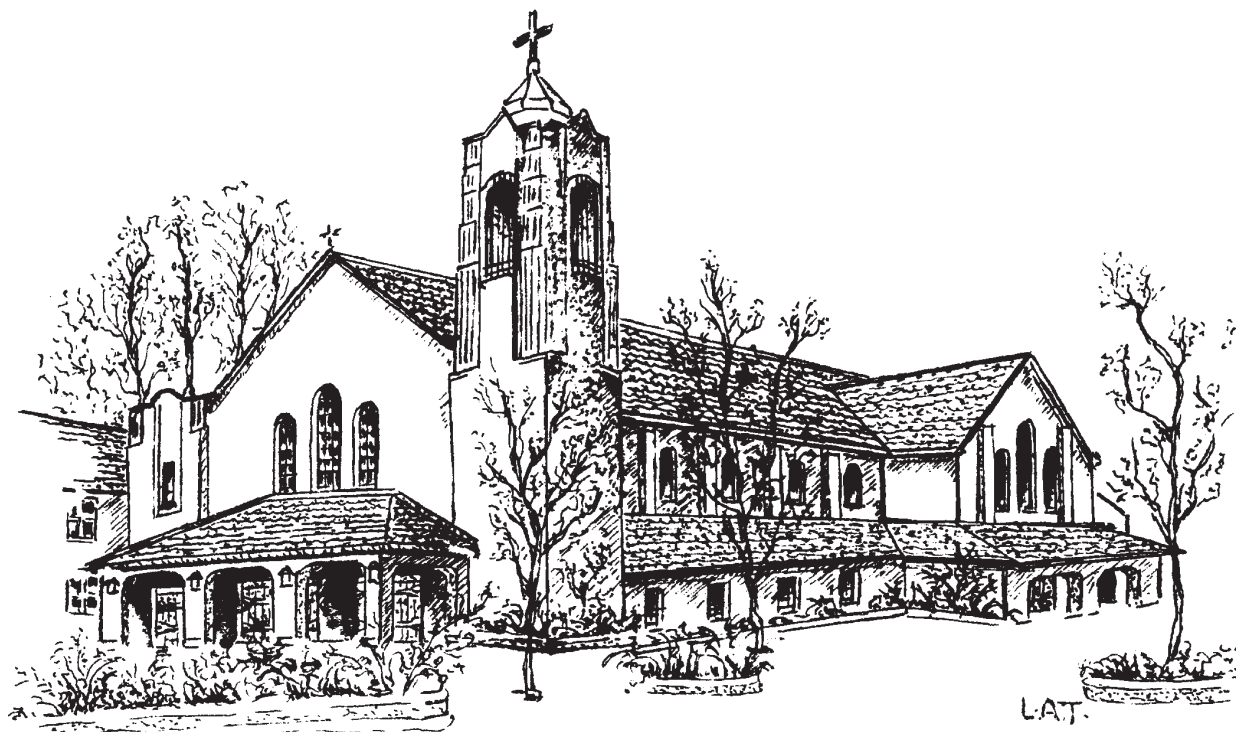

We have been reopened for almost a month now and things have gone very smoothly. Thanks to our amazing team of volunteers for helping make things go smoothly and safely. Special thanks to Linda Dayler for leading our team and being at almost every liturgy to ensure things go without a hitch.

This coming Friday, March 19 is the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, Husband of Mary. Saint Joseph is the Patron of the Universal Church and of Canada and we are currently marking the year of Saint Joseph as declared by our Holy Father last December. We will have two Masses that day one at the usual time at 8:00am and one at 7:00pm in lieu of Stations of the Cross. After each Mass we will pray together the Litany of Saint Joseph for our world, for an end to the pandemic, and for our parish community. Please join us to honour Saint Joseph and pray for his intercession. Also, because it is a Solemnity, the requirement to abstain from meat that day is lifted.
