During the lovely month of May, we honour our Blessed Mother, Mary, and we lovingly acknowledge our mothers, grandmothers and great-grandmothers. We also remember the women who have been like mothers to us: Godmothers and others who have nurtured us spiritually and emotionally. God has blessed us with these extraordinary women: Special women who have forever shaped our lives and taught us how to be compassionate and generous.

In the scriptures, Mary's selfless devotion is an unspoken homily. Her love is a message that reflects the love of God and demonstrates the great love mothers have for their children.
