St. Ann, Pray For Us

THE LORD'S PRAYER: "OUR FATHER"

- AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION

This petition seems puzzling at first, because we know that God does not tempt us; temptation is the work of the devil. Here, knowledge of the Greek word translated into English as "lead" is helpful. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, "the Greek means both 'do not allow us to enter into temptation' and 'do not let us yield to temptation.'" A temptation is a trial; in this petition, we ask God to keep us from entering into trials that test our faith and virtue, and to keep us strong when we must face such trials.

The line "And lead us not into temptation" is a meaningful petition to God. It refers to the Lord saving us at the time of temptation. Throughout our lives, we will be faced with many trials and temptations. We ask that God help and strengthen us to face these difficulties and respond in the appropriate Christian way.

Trials are the misery and hardship that we all endure during the course of our lives. It may be the loss of a loved one or the news of cancer. With these trials we learn patience and humility. We realize that the material elements of life are not important or will grant us happiness, however, our relationship with God and others is paramount.

Temptations refer to doing something that is against God's will and we know is wrong. Some are tempted to cheat others, slander or commit adultery. Such actions break the commandments and are sinful. We ask the Lord to fortify us and be our loving shield when the potential for sin faces us.

Saint Augustine said: When we say: Lead us not into temptation, we are reminding ourselves to ask that his help may not depart from us; otherwise we could be seduced and consent to some temptation, or despair and yield to it.
