INDIGENOUS RECONCILIATION FUND

Beginning this Sunday and continuing next week we will be distributing envelopes at the doors of the church for The Indigenous Reconciliation Fund.

In May 2022, we held our first diocese-wide collection, asking for support that would add to the Diocese's original \$4 million commitment. Though the fund was new and had

neither projects nor committee members, parishioners responded generously – contributing in excess of \$170,000.

Since that time, the Diocese has formed our local Indigenous Reconciliation Fund advisory council, whose members are tasked with the ultimate funding decisions for local reconciliation projects. The advisory council, comprised of four Indigenous and three Diocesan representatives, will be the main point of contact with those local Indigenous groups who will work toward the funds four priorities: healing and reconciliation for communities and families; culture and language revitalization; education and community building; and dialogues for promoting Indigenous spirituality and culture.

Please be generous, pick up one of the envelopes and return it over the following weeks in the regular collection. Please make cheques payable to the parish so that tax receipts can be issued. Thank you for your consideration.
