Dear parishioners,

In His Apostolic Exhortation, Christus Vivit: Christ is Alive! Pope Francis reminds us that "The community has an important role in the accompaniment of young people; it should feel collectively responsible for accepting, motivating, encouraging and challenging them. All should regard young people with understanding, appreciation and affection, and avoid constantly judging them or demanding of them a perfection beyond their years" (Christus Vivit para. #243).
