It was wonderful to be on holiday and enjoy an extended family reunion these past weeks. My time in Vietnam was blessed in many ways, including by the rare opportunity to be with Dad on his 90th birthday. God is good!

Now I am back, very happy to return to you and especially to welcome a fine young priest to our community. Father Pierre Edward Luc will be in residence at St. Ann and assisting me for the coming year. God is good!

- Father Edward was born in Haiti and ordained to the diaconate in 2016 in Toronto, where he was very active in its Haitian community. He was ordained a Jesuit priest on August 5, 2017, in Port-au-Prince.
- Father is gifted, being fluent in four languages – Creole, French, Spanish and English – and earning bachelor’s degrees in philosophy and theology. He will soon obtain his master’s degree in theology from Regis College, University of Toronto.

- Father Edward has ministered extensively in the Dominican Republic, Mexico and Haiti, teaching and working in Jesuit religious formation. In addition, he was National Director of the Jesuit Migrant Service in Haiti, gave retreats and provided spiritual direction. These missions were carried out with great joy and zeal.
- Now living his priesthood in the diocesan clergy, Father feels he can serve the universal Church while carrying the Haitian people and the Church of Haiti in his heart. What a gift to our parish as a whole, and to me as your pastor, to benefit from the influx of international priests. I am honoured, pleased to welcome Father and confident that you will receive him warmly. God is good!

Welcome, Father Edward, to the Parish of St. Ann! May God’s grace abound as we walk together in our journey of faith.
