Dr. Paul O'Byrne, Dean and Vice-President of McMaster University's Faculty of Health Sciences, has been appointed an Officer of the Order of Canada on December 28, one of Canada's highest civilian honours.

This recognition is for his contributions to asthma understanding and treatment. As a respirologist, Dr. O'Byrne is a clinicial-scientist, focusing on the role of environmental allergens in asthma.

He has authored numerous peer-reviewed articles, in the New England Journal of Medicine, The Lancet, and Nature Medicine.

Join the Pastoral Team; The Three Amigos: Fr. Peter, Fr. Edward and David for a five-week study session of the Gospel of Mark.

This shortest of all New Testament gospels is likely the first to have been written, yet it often tells of Jesus' ministry in more detail than either Matthew or Luke. It recounts what Jesus did in a vivid style, where one incident follows directly upon another. In this almost breathless narrative, Mark stresses Jesus' message about the kingdom of God now breaking into human life as good news and Jesus himself as the gospel of God. Jesus is the Son whom God has sent to rescue humanity by serving and by sacrificing his life.

We will begin Thursday, February 22nd, at 7- 8:30 p.m. and continue for 5 weeks ending on Thursday, March 21.

Thursday February 21: An Introduction to the Gospel

Thursday February 28: Chapters 1-4 – Preparing the Way Thursday March 7: Chapters 5-8 – Parables & Miracles Thursday March 14: Chapters 9 – 12 – Jesus Teachings Thursday March 21: Chapter 13-16 – Predictions, Plots & The Passion

Together we will discover how Mark's gospel presents us a Savior who is truly divine, truly man, and who gives His life uniquely as a substitutionary atonement for the sins of His people. We benefit from His death by faith, even as we learn from Him that the way of glory is the way of suffering.
