

Lent: Opening the Gifts of the Holy Spirit (material from Thomas Richstatter, O.F.M., S.T.D.)

Lent is a time to renew the grace – the Spirit – of the beautiful gifts of the Holy Spirit that were gifted to us through our Baptism, Confirmation and reception of the Eucharist.

During this first week of Lent, I encourage you to open the gift of understanding.

A gift is just a gift until we open it and use it! Understanding is to "stand under," to "get to the bottom of things."

Sometimes in order to understand how to use a gift we need to read the directions.

God's gift of Easter life comes with directions also – the sacred Scriptures.

Prayerful reading and studying of the Bible helps us to understand God's plan in our lives.

We read in the Psalms: "I have more understanding than all my teachers, because I ponder your decrees ... the revelation of your words shed light, give understanding to the simple". (Psalm 119:99)

St. Francis of Assisi was a simple man who enjoyed the Gift of Understanding, Pray with him, in his words: "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace ... Grant that we may not so much seek to be understood, as to understand."

Challenge for the Week: This week I challenge you to reread or listen to the Bible passages from Sunday's liturgy, and spend some quiet time in reflection on the readings.
