CONSIDERATION AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I, the participant, in consideration of being permitted by The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of Hamilton in Ontario, operating as _____ Parish (hereinafter referred to as the “**Diocese**”) to participate in the Walking Pilgrimage hereby agree as follows:

- I UNDERSTAND THAT my activities during the Walking Pilgrimage may involve certain elements of risk. Injuries can occur while travelling or participating in these activities. The risk of sustaining injuries, or loss and damage to property can occur without any fault of either the Participant, the Diocese, its employees/agents, volunteers or the road way/ path/facility where the Walking Pilgrimage activities are taking place. Other inherent risks include blisters, road rash, insect bites, sun stroke, dehydration, etc.
- I FREELY ACCEPT AND FULLY ASSUME all such risks and the possibility of personal injury, harm, illness, death, property damage or loss, and responsibility for losses, costs and damages, however caused, that I incur as a result of my participation as a Participant in the Walking Pilgrimage.
- I UNDERSTAND THAT, except as otherwise agreed to by the Diocese in writing, neither the Diocese nor any of the Releasees described below carries or maintains health, medical or disability insurance coverage for any Participants in the Walking Pilgrimage. It is my responsibility to ensure I have no medical issues which will prevent me from participating in the Walking Pilgrimage and that I have medical, personal health, dental and accident insurance coverage. I understand that any costs associated with the Participant’s medical care will be the participants’ responsibility.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

I, the Participant, in consideration of being permitted to participate in the Walking Pilgrimage, hereby on behalf of myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, freely and voluntarily, without duress, execute this Release under the following terms:

- TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against the Diocese, its past and present directors, officers, members, employees, Walking Pilgrimage leaders from the Diocese, Chaperones¹, other volunteers, affiliates, agents and representatives (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as the “**Releasees**”);

¹ All adult volunteers, 18 year of age and older, of the Diocese.

- TO RELEASE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE THE RELEASEES AND THEIR RESPECTIVE SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I may suffer, or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in the Walking Pilgrimage, due to any cause whatsoever;
- I HEREBY RELEASE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE the Releasees from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered to me in connection with an emergency during my participation in the Walking Pilgrimage.
- TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES and their respective successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, actions, causes of action and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, whether foreseen or unforeseen, which arise or may hereafter arise from my participation in the Walking Pilgrimage, for any damage to property of, or personal injury to, any third party, resulting from my participation in the Walking Pilgrimage and for any costs involved in connection with such claims;
- **EXCEPTING THAT** the forgoing waiver, release and indemnity shall not apply in the event the loss or damage to person or property is caused by the willful default or neglect of the Releasees, to the extent that such willful default or neglect causes or contributed to such damage.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT

I ACKNOWLEDGE that I, and I alone, am responsible for my personal health and safety, and the personal property I bring with me. In the event of injury or medical emergency, I give permission for myself/my child to be evaluated, diagnosed, treated and/or given medication in accordance with standard medical practice by licensed medical personnel. In the event of a minor child, I understand that attempts to contact me will be made, if necessary.

CONDUCT OF PARTICIPANT AND RESPONSIBILITIES

I ACKNOWLEDGE that in the course of participating in the Walking Pilgrimage, I will not engage in any illegal activities, which contravene (or appear to contravene) any section of the *Criminal Code* of Canada, as well as any applicable municipal, provincial and federal laws, bylaws and regulations. I will also follow all instructions of Diocese representatives and/or Chaperones and acknowledge that failure to act accordingly may result in me being dismissed at my own expense.

PROPRIETARY AND CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

I GRANT AND CONVEY unto the Diocese all right, title and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by the Diocese's officers, employees, volunteers, Chaperones, helpers or Walking Pilgrimage leaders during my participation in the Walking Pilgrimage, including, but not limited to, any moral rights, royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

I also waive any and all rights, including moral rights, that I have in the photographic images and video or audio recordings made by any of the Diocese's assignees and licensees. I understand and agree that the Diocese may use, modify and/or publish the photographic images and video or audio recordings or portions thereof in any manner it considers appropriate.

I acknowledge and authorize the Diocese to retain this agreement, which contains certain personal information, in perpetuity. This agreement shall be kept in a secure and confidential facility with limited access only by the Bishop of Hamilton or his designate.

WARNING ABOUT WAIVER OF RIGHTS

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS AND ASSIGNS MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES. I AGREE THAT THIS AGREEMENT BE INTERPRETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF ONTARIO AND THE COURTS OF ONTARIO SHALL HAVE SOLE JURISDICTION.

WALKING PILGRIMAGE GUIDELINES

Safety

- Pay attention to and heed the instructions pilgrimage leaders.
- Walk on the inside edge of the sidewalk so you are further away from traffic.
- If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic so you can see oncoming vehicles.
- Walk well to the left side of the road and in single file: up steep hills, approaching crests of hills, and blind corners.
- Obey pedestrian signals and only cross at intersections or marked crosswalks.
- Do not jaywalk.
- Make eye contact with drivers. Keep your head up while walking. Never assume that drivers see you.
- Always look for signs that a vehicle is about to move – rear lights, exhaust smoke, sound of motor, wheels turning.
- Watch for vehicles turning at intersections or backing out of driveways.
- Dress to be seen – wear bright, light-coloured clothing or reflective strips.
- Ensure you can hear and see oncoming vehicles. Avoid distractions like texting or wearing earphones. Remove your hood when crossing the street.
- Notify a pilgrimage leader if you need a support vehicle.

Recommendations

- Wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the weather.
- Apply sunblock and bug spray, as necessary.
- Have in your possession any medications you may need to take. Participants are responsible for their own personal health and care of any medical conditions.

Respect on the Walking Pilgrimage

- The Diocese of Hamilton is committed to providing a safe environment free of harassment, violence and discrimination.
- All participants shall treat others on the Walking Pilgrimage with respect and courtesy. The Diocese does not tolerate harassment, bullying or intimidation.
