Sent with Joy, Rooted in Christ

In this Sunday's Gospel, we witness Jesus sending out seventy-two disciples, two by two, into the towns and villages ahead of Him. He gives them a mission: to proclaim peace, to heal the sick, and to announce that "the kingdom of God has come near."

This is not just a story of ancient evangelists, it is a message for us today. Jesus sends *us* too. Wherever we go, into our homes, neighborhoods, workplaces, we are called to be bearers of peace, hope and signs of God's nearness. Like the disciples, we do not go alone. We go in communion with one another and empowered by Christ.

The return of the seventy-two is full of joy. They marvel that even demons obey them. But Jesus gently shifts their focus: "Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." In other words, the true joy of discipleship does not come from success or power, but from our relationship with God and our belonging to His kingdom.

In a world so often marked by division and anxiety, may we be messengers of peace, hope and signs of God's love. And may our greatest joy be knowing that we are held by God, chosen and sent in His name.

Questions to Reflect On:

- Where is Jesus sending me this week?
- How can I be a source of peace and hope in my daily life?
- Do I find joy and hope in being close to Christ, even when I see no "visible" results?

Let us go forth, like the seventy-two, with faith, humility, and joy.
