

A Grateful Welcome to Our New Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, C.S.M.A.

St. Ann's Parish in Ancaster joins with joy and gratitude with the entire Diocese of Hamilton in welcoming its new pastor, Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, C.S.M.A., on the eve of his official installation as bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton.

On November 1, 2025, His Holiness Pope Leo XIV announced the appointment of Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, then Bishop of Charlottetown and former Auxiliary Bishop of London, as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton. By accepting this call, Bishop Dabrowski became our bishop, and since that moment, his name, Joseph, has been mentioned in the Eucharistic prayers celebrated in all the parishes of the diocese.

Tomorrow, February 2, 2026, on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, Bishop Dabrowski will officially take possession of the episcopal see of Hamilton. During a solemn celebration at Christ the King Cathedral Basilica, he will present the decree of appointment to the College of Consultors, marking the official transfer of pastoral and administrative responsibility for the diocese. This event is a deeply significant moment in the life of the local Church as we welcome the one who is called to guide, teach, and sanctify us in the name of Christ.

We give thanks to God for the gift of a bishop to a dynamic and blessed diocese, animated by a diverse and committed people of faith. The Diocese of Hamilton can count on well-established ministries and pastoral services, strong Catholic institutions in education and health care, and a pastoral and administrative staff dedicated to the mission of the Church. Bishop Dabrowski will also be able to draw on the quality of the formation offered to our 20 seminarians, who are called to become the pastors of tomorrow.

On the eve of this important milestone, the community of St. Ann extends its warmest welcome to Bishop Dabrowski. We assure him of our faithful prayers and support, so that his ministry among us may be fruitful and filled with wisdom, love, compassion, and hope.

Welcome, Bishop Joseph. May the Holy Spirit accompany you in your mission, and may the Lord abundantly bless your service to the people of God in the Diocese of Hamilton.
