Embrace mercy, sow peace

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, our gaze turns to the Risen Christ, whose open heart remains an inexhaustible source of love, forgiveness, and peace. Through this feast, we are invited to rediscover that mercy is not merely an attribute of God, but the very heart of his message: a love that gives itself without measure and lifts up all who suffer.

In a world deeply marked by conflicts, tensions, and the suffering of so many peoples, this celebration takes on a special resonance. The news we receive each day reminds us how fragile peace is and how much humanity needs healing. Faced with these realities, we might be tempted by discouragement or a sense of powerlessness. Yet the Gospel of mercy opens another path for us: that of trust and prayer.

On this day, we are invited to pray earnestly for God's mercy upon our world. Let us pray for regions torn apart by war, for the victims of violence, for families in mourning and those who have been displaced. Let us also pray for those in positions of responsibility, that they may have the courage to seek justice and build true peace. Humble and persevering prayer is a real force that reaches the heart of God and opens unexpected paths.

However, the mercy we implore is also the mercy we are called to live. To be Disciples of Christ is to become, in our own small way, artisans of mercy and peace. This begins with the simple gestures of daily life: forgiving an offense, reaching out to those who are isolated, listening without judging, responding to harshness with gentleness. These small acts, often unseen, help to transform the world in a profound way. May this Divine Mercy Sunday rekindle in each of us the certainty that God's love is stronger than any form of evil. May it grant us the grace to be credible witnesses of this mercy, and may the peace our world so desperately needs grow a little more through our lives, wherever we are.
