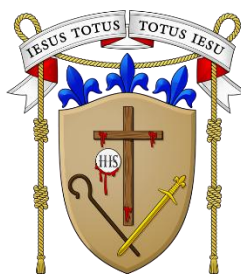
I look forward to continuing our journey of faith together as we grow ever closer to Christ and strengthen our parish community.
