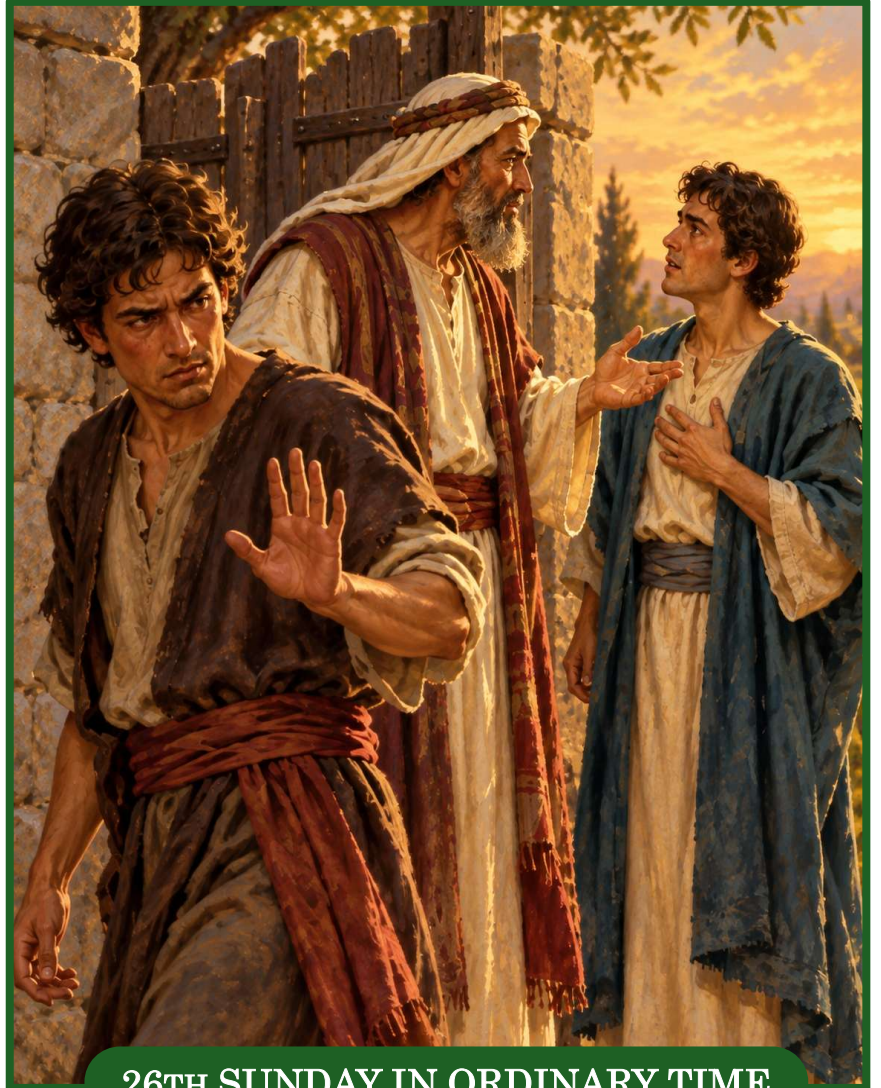

BAILEYS CAKE

A rich and moist cake with a delicious glaze.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 box instant chocolate pudding mix
- 1 cup milk
- ½ cup vegetable oil
- 4 eggs
- ½ cup Baileys Irish Cream

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Preheat:** Preheat oven to 325°F
2. **Prepare Pan:** Grease and lightly flour a Bundt pan.
3. **Mix:** In a large bowl, mix all ingredients together until well combined
4. **Bake:** Pour the batter into the prepared pan and bake for 1 hour, or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
5. **Cool:** Allow the cake to cool completely before glazing.

GLAZE:

- 1 tbsp. melted butter
- 1 tbsp. Baileys Irish Cream
- 6 tbsp. Icing Sugar

Mix all ingredients together with a fork. When the cake is completely cool, drizzle the glaze over the cake

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL



September 27th is the Feast Day of St. Vincent de Paul, a French priest who served as chaplain to the poor and imprisoned. He founded the Congregation of the Mission and the Daughters of Charity.

He is known as the epitome of Christian charity, seeing the face of Christ in all those who suffer. We reflect today on his charity, empathy and compassion for those experiencing poverty and hardship. He died in 1660. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, founded in 1833 by Blessed Frédéric Ozanam, now has more than a million members worldwide.

This year marks the 50th Anniversary of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul Conference at St. Ann Parish. Our members continue to serve the poor and marginalized in our community and surrounding area through the distribution of food vouchers, clothing, furniture, as well as many other social justice initiatives.

A special blessing for members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul will take place at **the 11:00 a.m. Mass**, followed by a blessing with the St. Vincent de Paul relic.

Our next collection will be on October 3rd/4th.
