MAPLE GLAZE SALMON

A simple and delicious salmon dish!

INGREDIENTS:

- 4–6 Salmon Portions
- 1/3 Cup Real Maple Syrup
- 3 Tbsp. Soy Sauce
- 1 ½ Tbsp. Dijon Mustard
- 1 ½ Tsp. Garlic Puree or 2 Crushed Cloves

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Prep:** Preheat oven to 375°F.
2. **Mix:** Mix all ingredients together in a bowl
3. **Combine:** Place salmon on a baking sheet, pour 3/4 of mixture on salmon.
4. **Bake:** Bake for 15-25 minutes, after 10 minutes drizzle more of the mixture on top and finish cooking. Remove from oven and brush the remaining mixture on the salmon and serve.

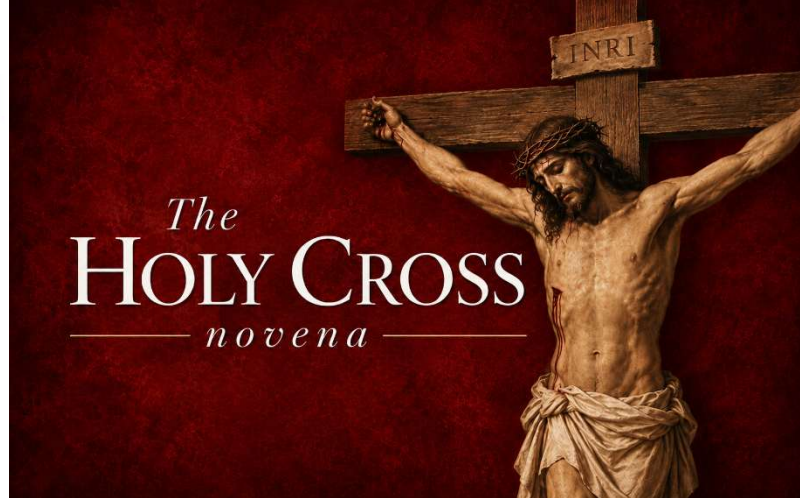
