HOMEMADE AREPAS

Quick and easy homemade arepas.

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 ½ cups of room temperature water
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups pre-cooked cornmeal
- ¼ cup vegetable oil

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Mix:** Combine 2½ cups room temperature water and 1 teaspoon salt. Gradually add 2 cups pre-cooked white cornmeal, mixing and kneading until a soft, moist dough forms.
2. **Shape & Fry:** Divide the dough into 8 balls and flatten each into a round patty about 2 inches wide and ⅜ inch thick. Heat ¼ cup vegetable oil in a skillet over medium heat and fry the arepas for 4–5 minutes per side, until golden brown.
3. **Drain & Serve:** Drain the arepas on a paper towel-lined plate.
